Why We Conducted This Audit

We conducted certain procedures at the Office of Lieutenant Governor and the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism to evaluate their accountability over public funds and compliance with state law for the period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2014.


What We Found

We evaluated controls and transactions relating to cash, movable property, revenues, payroll expenditures, non-payroll expenditures, and Louisiana Seafood Promotion and Marketing Board activities. We found these controls provided reasonable assurance of accountability over public funds for the period examined.

Revenues for the Office of State Parks (OSP) decreased by 9% in 2013 as a result of park closures due to damage caused by Hurricane Isaac. This decrease in revenue collections appears to be consistent with the decrease in visitation activity.
