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Why We Conducted This Audit

We conducted certain procedures at Louisiana State University in Shreveport (University) to evaluate its accountability over public funds for the period July 1, 2011, through May 29, 2013.

What We Found

We evaluated controls and transactions relating to athletics and bookstore cash receipts, asset management system usage, professional services contracts, scholarship expenditures, procurement card usage, return of Title IV funds, and potential overawards related to Student Financial Aid Cluster programs. We found no matters that require disclosure in this report.

We compared current and prior year financial information and determined the changes in accounts to be reasonable.

As shown in the four-year trend analysis below, the University's enrollment and completion rates have remained fairly consistent. The University has placed a greater reliance on tuition increases and other revenues to offset the decreases in its state appropriations and federal funding.
